## Thank you for purchasing a Mustard Bikes Fender Eliminator. The following is a brief guide for installation of your Triumph 675 Fender Eliminator.



- 1. Remove rear seat using the key.
- 2. Locate rear fender wiring harness and disconnect the plug from the main harness.
- 3. Remove stock fender by removing 4x 8mm bolts and gently pulling away from bike.
- 4. Leave the stock rubber vibration damper on the underside of the tail in place.
- 5. Remove the 4mm Allen bolt on the underside of the stock fender.
- 6. Gently pry the two spring clips off the reflector and remove from fender.
- 7. Behind the reflector remove 2 x bolts and nuts.
- 8. Remove 5mm Allen bolts holding the indicators to the stock fender.
- 9. Gently pry apart the two halves of the stock fender to gain access to the fender wiring harness.
- 10. Disconnect the two indicators and the number plate light from the harness.
- 11. Refit the stock indicators to the fender eliminator using the stock bolts and 2x supplied Nylock nuts.
- 12. Fit OEM number plate light plug to the LED bolt. The LED bolt is polarity sensitive.
- 13. If it does not light up switch the wires around and check again.
- 14. Feed all wiring through the main wiring hole and retain in place using cable ties.
- 15. Place supplied spacer rings over the original collars and hold in place with a small amount of blu-tak or house hold tape as per the picture.
- 16. Offer assembly up to bike, feeding wiring into the bike.
- 17. Bolt in place with 3 of the 4 OEM bolts and the remaining supplied Nylock nuts.
- 18. Plug in indicators and LED bolt to original fender harness and plug fender harness back into the main harness.
- 19. Check lighting for correct operation.
- 20. Refit rider's seat.
