Thank you for purchasing a Mustard Bikes Fender Eliminator. The following is a brief guide for installation of your Yamaha MT-09 Fender Eliminator.

- 1. Remove rider seat from bike.
- 2. Remove 2 x bolts from each side rear seat cowling (10mm hex socket), 4 in total.
- 3. Remove 4 x push plugs from underneath the left side seat cowling and remove cowling.
- 4. Remove 3 x push plugs from underneath the right side seat cowling and remove cowling.
- 5. Remove the lock plate from sub-frame (4 x 8mm hex socket).
- 6. Unplug indicator and number plate light plugs (located right hand inside of sub-frame).
- 7. Remove 4 x nuts (4 x 10mm hex socket) holding stock fender and remove stock fender.
- 8. Remove 4 x bolts from top side of stock fender (4mm allen) and 4 x Phillips screw from underside.
- 9. Remove indicators and fit to fender eliminator after fitting supplied spacers (Oval rings).
- 10. Fit fender eliminator base to bike using 4 x 16 mm bolts and stock nuts.
- 11. Feed Fender Eliminator wiring through and fit fender eliminator to base using 3 x supplied M6 nuts.
- 12. Plug in wiring for indicators and number plate light and check for operation.
- 13. If LED bolt does not light up switch the two wires (LED bolt is polarity sensitive).
- 14. Refit lock plate to sub-frame (4 x 8mm hex socket).
- 15. Refit left and right rear cowling panels replacing all push plugs and 4 x bolt (10mm hex socket).
- 16. Use supplied cap to cover seat lock.
- 17. Refit rider's seat.
